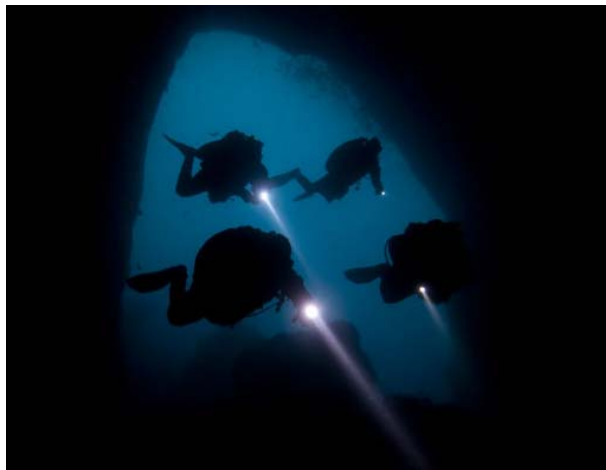
Oceanblue Live-aboard trip
