

Course Overview

The objective of the course is to train divers in the benefits, hazards and proper procedures for utilizing air through to 100% oxygen to plan and conduct a standard staged decompression dive not exceeding a maximum depth of 45m.

Prerequisites

To enrol in the course, you must be 18 years of age, show proof of 25 logged open water dives and be certified as a TDI Nitrox Diver (or equivalent). You should also be familiar with twin tank diving.

What's Involved

This course has three components: Knowledge development, confined water skills development and open water dives. These will be scheduled to suit divers enrolled in each course. In total a minimum of 6 dives are required with an accumulated bottom time of at least 100 minutes.

Course Skills

Out of gas drills, gas switching, problem management and ascent procedures, valve drills, buoyancy and trim, SMB deployment, free-flowing deco gas.

Why Do the Course?

This course will appeal to all divers that want to go beyond the limiting factors of recreational diving: time and depth. By providing you with the necessary knowledge and skills to safely conduct dives in 'the virtual overhead', you will be able to enjoy more of what you crave – being underwater.

What's Included

The course fee covers instructional time, gas costs, use of stage reg. and bottle and certification costs only. Students are expected to pay any boat costs required to complete the course, although shore dives can be used to minimise these costs.

What You Need

In addition to standard scuba equipment, students are required to have a spare mask, timing device, a delayed surface marker buoy, a spool/reel with 30m of line and a stage bottle and reg. We also require that this course is conducted using manifolded twin cylinders. These may be rented for the duration of the course. Students who are not familiar with the use of twin tanks and long hose management should first complete the one day twin tanks workshop.
