

Course Overview

GUE's Doubles course is designed to prepare divers for diving a double tank/cylinder configuration using proper equipment and techniques. In this class, students will be trained in the use of double tanks/cylinders and in the potential failure problems associated with them.

Prerequisites

To enrol in the course, you must be 16 years of age, be a certified open water diver from a recognized training agency, be able to swim a distance of at least 50 feet/15 meters on a breath hold and be able to swim at least 300 yards/275 meters in less than 14 minutes without stopping. Please note that GUE does not allow smokers on any of their courses.

What's Involved

The GUE Doubles course is normally conducted over a very intense 2 day period. Combining lectures and practical (in-water) sessions, this course focuses on increasing proficiency with double tanks, through proper control of buoyancy, trim, propulsion, teamwork and other GUE principles.

Course Skills

Propulsion and manoeuvring techniques, managing your equipment, Valve drill, S-drill, teamwork, reserve light deployment, SMB deployment, ascent and descent procedures, buoyancy and trim.

Why Do the Course?

Do you want to go diving with double tanks but don't know where to start? This one weekend course is the perfect introduction to double tank diving. By increasing the amount of gas available as well as building in redundancy, double tanks allow for extended dive durations and more challenging dives, such as those in the overhead environment. However, double tank diving is more complex than single tank diving and if undertaken casually can increase risk rather than reducing it. The aim of this course is to help you become a competent double tank diver and ensure that you maintain your solid foundational skills as you move to a more complex equipment configuration.

What's Included

The course fee covers all instructional time, gas fills and pool fees. Students pay certification and course material costs directly to GUE.

What You Need

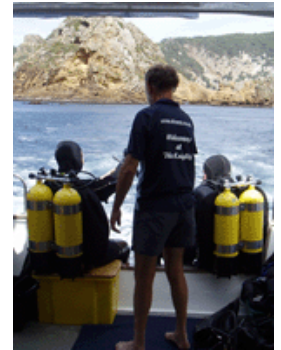
